What are your qualifications for this office?

I was born and raised in Sonoma County, and have spent most of my life working hard for the community that raised me. I have a BA in Political Science from UC Santa Barbara and a Masters in Public Administration from Sonoma State University.

Prior to my service on the Santa Rosa City Council, I worked for nearly a decade as legislative and district staff for: Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey, Assemblymembers Michael Allen and Mariko Yamada, and Senators Pat Wiggins and Mike McGuire. I recently finished a stint as the Executive Director for Sonoma County Conservation Action.

During my tenure as Mayor (December 2020 to December 2022), I accomplished what hadn't been achieved in nearly a decade: balancing the budget. I prioritized people by expanding access to affordable childcare and launching a groundbreaking first-time home-buyers program for low-income workers. I championed initiatives like free public transit for veterans, seniors, and youth while safeguarding the rights of seniors in mobile home parks.

In my role as a Councilmember and Mayor, I have served on regional, statewide and national associations with Cal Cities and National League of Cities. Also, I serve as the Chair of the Sonoma County Transportation Authority, Regional Climate Protection Authority, and as a Director on Sonoma Clean Power.

What campaign experience and training have you had?

I have been an elected member of the Santa Rosa City Council in 2016 - this was an at-large race where I faced immense opposition from a well funded Super PAC that spent hundreds of thousands of dollars to defeat my candidacy. At the time, this was the most expensive council race in my City's history. In 2018 we switched to district elections so when I ran for re-election in 2020 I was elected this time from District 5.

As a former legislative staffer I volunteered on numerous legislative campaigns to elect Democrats to the Legislature.

In 2013, I was hired to manage the campaign of one of my mentors Mike McGuire when he was running for the state Senate.
